New Braunfels Utilities Announces Road Closure on East San Antonio Street From South Gilbert Avenue to South Union Street, May 20 – 24, 2019

(New Braunfels, TX – May 13, 2019) – New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) will be performing utility work and will close the roads at East San Antonio Street at the Comal River Bridge from South Gilbert Avenue to South Union Avenue on Monday, May 20 through Friday, May 24, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

New Braunfels Utilities crews will relocate existing electrical infrastructure and NBU fiber lines. Charter Communications (Spectrum) will be performing work along with NBU to have all utilities transferred and removed at the same time.

Traffic controls signs will be in place to safely guide traffic though the area. The closure is necessary in order to maneuver equipment, materials, and crews safely. For additional information, please call 830.608.8951.

Work is expected to be completed in the timeframe noted, pending weather and other factors.
