New Braunfels Utilities to Temporarily Close Road and Provide Detour on Morningside Drive

(New Braunfels, TX – January 9, 2019) –New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) announces a temporary road closure and detour on Morningside Drive. On Friday January 11, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. the closure will be in place near the juncture of Morningside Drive and Solms Road, necessitating a detour for through traffic. Local traffic that does not need to pass through that juncture will not be affected. This same roadway segment will close again on Sunday, January 13, 2019 from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Detour signs will be in place, however local residents, businesses, and CISD staff will be able to reach their Morningside Drive destinations by traveling westward on Morningside Drive. Those traveling to locations on S. Solms Road should access that road from the IH 35 access road. The location of the construction is 5798 Morningside Drive.

This temporary closure is necessary for the installation of a sewer line across this section of Morningside Drive as part of the City's 2013 Bond Program improvements.

Work is expected to be completed in the timeframe noted, pending weather and other factors.
