We understand and respect just how important this is for our community. Taking efforts to assure street lights are readily available, which are designed to direct light on to where it is needed, distributes light more efficiently and effectively. That helps to reduce glare, power consumption, and cost - and allows individuals to enjoy the night (the dark skies).

“New Braunfels Utilities is committed to supporting practices that limit, or minimize, light trespass from street light fixtures in order to preserve our starry night skies. It is important to NBU to promote and encourage street lighting fixtures and practices that follow the most current guidelines and use available technologies for efficient, non-intrusive lighting, and to help educate and encourage landowners, businesses, residential neighborhoods, and public entities to join in the commitment to reduce energy consumption, save money, and protect the beauty of the night skies,” said, Ian Taylor, CEO, NBU.
