Guidelines for NBU Solar Water Heater Rebate Program

- Applicant must have an active residential electric service account with NBU at time of purchase and installation.
- Solar water heaters must be SRCC (Solar Rating Certification Corp.) certified and a closed loop system. The rebate amount is \$0.265 per kWh on the SRCC scale of 1200 to 3400 kWh (i.e. $3400 \times \$0.265 = \901.00).
- All equipment must be new, with frost protection, and installed by a qualified NABCEP certified contractor (see list).
- Solar water heaters must preheat water for an electric water heater that is permanently installed and is the main source of water heating.
- The solar water heater must have a minimum 5 year warranty on collector and tank.
- Manufacturer's installation procedures and local city codes will be followed. The installation location must provide maximum benefit of the selected equipment.
- Purchase and installation must be between August 1, 2013 and July 31, 2014 and application received by NBU by July 31, 2014.
- Installation contractor must be NABCEP (North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners) certified for solar thermal (ST) and certification number provided (see list).
- Contractors invoice/receipt must include documentation for all requirements as stated above.
- **NBU reserves the right to terminate this program at any time.**
