2019 Consumer Confidence Report (Water Quality Report) Now Available

(New Braunfels, TX – June 5, 2019) The annual New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) Consumer Confidence Report, often referred to as the Water Quality Report, is now available to view online at nbutexas.com/2019waterreport.

New Braunfels Utilities prepares an annual water quality report for its customers on its NBU water system. The report summarizes the results of NBU's water monitoring program as required by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) during January 1 through December 31, 2018. The analyses are required by the Safe Drinking Water Act; however, NBU monitors for contaminants above and beyond the basic requirements. The report is a summary of the quality of water NBU provides its customers, but more importantly, it is their assurance that the water NBU supplies is regulated and continues to meet or exceed all federal and state drinking water requirements.

New Braunfels Utilities has met and surpassed all state and federal drinking water standards, earning the Superior water rating by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Unless otherwise indicated, the information in the report is based on tests conducted in 2018.
