(New Braunfels, TX – October 4, 2019) – New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) will close the outer lane from the Main Plaza towards Mill Street in the 100 Block of North Seguin Avenue on Wednesday, October 10, 2019, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to allow crews to work on the area’s water infrastructure.

Traffic controls signs will be in place to safely guide traffic though the area.
