## New Braunfels Utilities Announces Lane Closure on South Seguin Avenue and the 100 Block of Garden Street

(New Braunfels, TX – December 6, 2019) – New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) will be performing water infrastructure maintenance in the 400 Block of South Seguin Avenue, and the 100 Block of Garden Street, between South Seguin Avenue and Comal Avenue, from December 9 – 11, 2019. The outer lane on South Seguin Avenue towards the Plaza will be closed from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and the 100 Block on Garden Street will be closed during this time while work is being done.

Traffic controls signs will be in place to safely guide traffic though the area.

The closure is necessary in order to maneuver equipment, materials, and crews safely. For additional information, please call 830.608.8831.

Work is expected to be completed in the timeframe noted, pending weather and other factors.
