

HOW TO READ YOUR SMART WATER METER

1. **Rate of Flow** - Indicates how many gallons of water per minute are flowing through the meter.
2. **Flow Direction** - Indicates which way the water is flowing through the meter.
3. **Low Battery Alarm** - Indicates a low battery and transmits this data to NBU for servicing.
4. **Leak Alarm** - Indicates that there has been a sustained flow through the meter which is suspect of a leak.
5. **Alert** - Indicates a mechanical or electronic issue with the meter.
6. **Factor** - Multiply this number by a daily read difference to determine a gallon total.
7. **Totalization** - Indicates how many gallons have flowed through the meter over its lifetime.
8. **AMR Digit Highlighter** - Helps identify numbers other than placeholders.
9. **Unit of Measure** - NBU water meters read in gallons.
