
TOGETHER, WE CAN WEATHER ANY OUTAGE

Being prepared for storms is part of New Braunfels Utilities' (NBU) standard operating procedure, and NBU resources allow customers to be prepared as well.

Our control center plays a significant role in providing critical updates to our crews and our community. It is manned 24-hours a day, every day. It serves as the central hub for maintaining and responding to incidents on both sunny and stormy days.

Control systems operators also respond to after-hour phone calls regarding outages. They send out auto alerts to customers who opt in for the text-message alerts.



In addition, they can access current weather conditions on the map, including radar.
