- _____ I understand topsoil must be a minimum of four inches deep and soils must be comprised of a minimum of 25 percent compost or organic matter.
- _____ I understand that replacing the grass with artificial turf is not eligible for this rebate.

_____ I agree to remove or cap any irrigation spray heads, rotors, or drip line from the replaced area.

_____ I understand that my project will be disqualified from the rebate if I use this as an opportunity to prep for the installation of a swimming pool, hot tub, ornamental fountain, or pond.

_____ I understand that to qualify for the rebate, I must install a permeable, non-grass surface.

_____ I understand all rebates and supporting documents must be submitted within one year of the work being performed.

_____ I agree to allow NBU to perform any necessary inspections, both during initial installation and in the future.

_____ I understand that this rebate has a max payout of \$2000 per 12 months, which will be applied as a rebate credit on my NBU water bill.

_____ I understand NBU reserves the right to terminate this program at any time and only NBU approved applications are eligible for payment under this rebate program.

_____ I understand NBU reserves the right to deny any rebate request if the applicant does not conform to the program guidelines, rules and specifications; no exceptions.
